

## Non-U.S. Citizen – Adult Original Or Replacement Social Security Card

To get an <u>original</u> card, you must show us documents proving your immigration status, age, identity and work eligibility.

To get a <u>replacement</u> card, you must show us documents proving your immigration status, identity and work eligibility. You must also show us a document proving your age, if it is not already in our records.

All documents must be current (not expired).

To prove	You must show
Your immigration status	<ul> <li>One of the following documents:</li> <li>I-94, Arrival/Departure Record, issued when you arrived in the United States;</li> <li>I-20, Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student Status (students only);</li> <li>DS-2019, Certificate of Eligibility for Exchange Visitor Status (exchange visitors only);</li> <li>Employment Authorization Card (I-766 or I-688B); or</li> <li>Form I-551 (Permanent Resident Card).</li> </ul>
Your age	<ul> <li>One of the following documents:</li> <li>Birth certificate;</li> <li>Passport; or</li> <li>A Department of Homeland Security document.</li> </ul>
Your identity	<ul> <li>One of the following documents:</li> <li>U.S. driver's license;</li> <li>State-issued nondriver's identification card;</li> <li>Form I-551 (Permanent Resident Card);</li> <li>I-94, Arrival/Departure Record; or</li> <li>Employment Authorization Card (I-766 or I-688B).</li> </ul>
Your work eligibility	<ul> <li>One of the following documents:</li> <li>I-94, Arrival/Departure Record;</li> <li>Work permits from the Department of Homeland Security (I-766 or I-688B);</li> <li>Form I-551 (Permanent Resident Card); or</li> <li>Immigrant visa showing temporary employment authorization</li> </ul>

You must present **original documents** or **copies certified by the agency** that issued them. We cannot accept photocopies or notarized copies.
