POLICY: Laboratory specimens are obtained, safely packaged and transported

to the Oregon State Health Department laboratory for the purpose of

testing.

PROCEDURE:

A. Tests performed by the Oregon State Health Department are:

HIV

TB Sputum Smear and Culture

B. Equipment needed:

Biohazard Mailers

7 ml red top tubes

Sputum receptacles

Transport bag (Pre-addressed or orange/opaque plastic)

Appropriate requisitions

Appropriate venipuncture supplies (see Policy and Procedure #P-D-04.10)

- C. With the exception of HIV specimens, all specimens must be labeled with the patient's full name, SID number and the specimen collection date, and must be accompanied by the appropriate completed request form.
- D. For appropriate request forms and specimen specification, refer to the Oregon State Health Department Laboratory Guide to Services Manual
- E. Supplies to perform routine specimen collection, request forms and mailing supplies may be obtained from the Oregon State Health Department Laboratory.
- F. All specimens must be sent in mailers (addressed cardboard cylinders) placed in transport bags with the requisition and specimen included. More than one (but no more than four) specimens can be sent in a single mailer. Mailer will be sent to the laboratory in an orange biohazard mailing bag provided by the state laboratory.
- G. Specimens should be mailed or sent by courier as soon as possible after collection.
