SUBJECT: GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR USE OF FORMALIN

POLICY: Safe handling of formalin is essential to minimize the risk of

exposure to formaldehyde. Each person involved with the use formalin is responsible for his/her own safety and compliance with these safety standards. Careful planning and organization

are critical to maintaining a safe working environment.

PROCEDURE:

- A. Procedures requiring the use of formalin will be conducted only in areas with an acceptable eyewash facility immediately available. The eye wash station must be able to provide a quantity of water sufficient to thoroughly cleanse the eyes until no evidence of chemical exposure remains.
- B. Contact of formalin to the employees' eyes and skin when handling containers of formalin, will be prevented by use of the personal protective equipment gloves and goggles.
- C. Should an employees' skin or eyes come in contact with formalin, they are to immediately flush the skin and/or eyes until no evidence of chemical exposure remains.
- D. Personal protective equipment contaminated with formalin will be disposed of in hot trash containers.
- E. Employees with formalin exposure to the eyes and appreciable exposure to the skin will be referred for medical care and follow-up. Employee exposure to formalin will be reported to the Health Service Manager and the institution safety officer and an accident report completed.
