- SUBJECT: RADIOLOGY SERVICES
- <u>POLICY</u>: A Quality radiology service for all Department of Corrections Health Services Departments is an essential component of inmate health care.
- <u>REFERENCE</u>: NCCHC Standard P-D-04, Diagnostic Services OAR 333-106-055

PROCEDURE:

In-house Services

- A. The correctional facilities provide general diagnostic radiology services for its clients.
- B. Diagnostic radiology services are performed only upon the request of the following ODOC staff: licensed physicians, nurse practitioners, physicians' assistants, consulting licensed physicians, dentists, or by protocols approved by the clinical director.
- C. Radiographs are sent out to consulting radiologists, certified by the American Board of Radiology, on a Monday through Friday basis.
- Films read by Cahaba Imaging are sent to them by express United Parcel Service. A copy of the written report is faxed to the originating facility within three (3) days. The films and authenticated interpretations are returned to the facilities within seven (7) working days.
- E. In the case of emergency "wet readings", films are read by local radiologists.
- F. If an emergency radiographic exam is needed outside the regular onsite x-ray department hours, the client will be transported to a licensed Radiology facility at Health Services discretion.

Services Provided at Outside Facilities

A. Patients are referred to local radiology departments when specialized procedures are ordered.

B. Specialized x-ray procedures referred to community radiology departments are as follows but not limited to:

Esophagram Colon Study Intravenous Pyelogram Ultrasound Nuclear Medicine Scan Arterial/venous studies Upper G.I. Series Cholecystogram Computerized Tomography Mammography Magnetic Resonance Imaging Other special procedures

C. Although there is no set facility where the above special exams must be done, the following facilities are accredited by the JCAHO or are staffed by persons certified by the American Board of Radiology in accordance with the state and local regulators.
