The EX-Ls, founded in 1982, is an association for retired and other former employees of Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory. It allows its ~300 members to enjoy and benefit from continued association with the Lab and with their fellow former employees.

The group holds quarterly luncheons, currently alternating between Spenger's and the Berkeley Yacht Club, featuring speakers who give us an update on research at the Lab or discuss topics of general interest. Recent speakers, for example, have talked about global warming; construction of the new east span of the Bay Bridge; California's water future; and new initiatives for LBNL (LBNL Director Steve Chu at the special 25th anniversary luncheon in November 2007).

The EX-Ls is part of the Lab's Employees Activities Association, which gives members access to the activities of that Association. For example, EX-Ls members who express an interest in doing so receive invitations to the local art and cultural events sponsored by the Employees Arts Council, including private, docent-led tours of major shows at the Fine Arts Museums of San Francisco. All LBNL retirees (whether or not they belong to the EX-Ls) are also eligible to participate in the activities of the UC Berkeley Retirement Center; see thecenter.berkeley.edu/

The EX-Ls is governed by a board of elected officers which meets quarterly. The group publishes a quarterly newsletter, the EX-Ls EX-PRESS. It contains information about the upcoming luncheon and speaker, board actions, and news of members' activities. A membership roster is included with the November newsletter each year.
