Can I take the GED® Tests online?

- No, the GED Tests are administered only at an Official GED Testing Center (see *Where do I go to take the tests?*).
- The GED certificate must be issued from a State Board of Education in the state in which you take the tests.

Information you need to know:

- There are thousands of diploma mills that operate without supervision of a state or professional agency and grant diplomas which are either fraudulent or lack proper standards to earn.
- There are legitimate high school diploma programs online—but you will not just pay a fee and then get a diploma. You have to take distance learning classes.
- There are also legitimate GED preparation programs online—again, only preparation programs. You cannot take the official GED Tests online.
- If you are not certain about a program online, please call the State GED Administration office. We will help you research the legitimacy of the program.
