<p>SUBJECT INTEROPERABILITY FOR ELECTRONIC TOLLING</p>		

Any electronic toll collection operation on State Highways in Oregon shall use the same transponders (or “tags”) planned for use in the State of Washington as of the date of adoption of this policy. Furthermore, equipment that “reads” transponders at toll collection operations shall be capable of reading both the transponders (or “tags”) planned for use in the State of Washington as of the date of adoption of this policy, and transponders used for “Green Light” commercial vehicle operations as of the date of adoption of this policy.
