Eligibility: To participate in the Oregon Driver Excellence Scholarship Challenge, the

student must:

1. be at least sixteen (16) but no more than twenty one (18) years of age;

2. be enrolled in a recognized secondary (high) school;

3. have an overall 3.0 (or equivalent) or better grade point average (from the last grading period);

4. have completed an ODOT - TSD approved driver education program;

5. have a drivers' license for a period of six months;

6. have no record of traffic crashes;

7. have no record of, or pending action on, traffic violations;

8. have completed the required application;

*Note: Space is limited to 80 participants, selection for participation will be based on a first come, first served basis with one student from each location. Additional students may be considered if slots are available.
