Coffee Creek Correctional Facility (CCCF) is a multicustody prison accommodating all of the State of Oregon's female inmates. It provides intake and evaluation of all female and male inmates committed to state custody by the courts. CCCF was opened in October 2001 for minimum security inmates and then for medium security inmates in April of 2002.
