**Available Funds:** Up to \$9,000 is available for training of State Workforce Agency (SWA) adjudication staff.

**Background:** The National Judicial College (NJC) has created on-line training for adjudication staff under a grant from USDOL.

- Training costs per session are \$450.
- SWAs that wish to provide training for adjudicators may receive funds for additional employees to complete the training.
- For each adjudicator that the state agrees to fund to attend the NJC training, up to a maximum of 10, the SWA may receive funding for two additional adjudication staff, up to a maximum of 20.
- Funds for this project must be obligated by December 31, 2006; therefore, the state must register for available training promptly. The actual training sessions will continue to be conducted after December 2006.
- In the event that funds can not be liquidated within thirty days of the obligation deadline, December 31, 2006, the state should request an extension of the liquidation of the grant.
