## Public Law 108-26 108th Congress

## An Act

To extend the Temporary Extended Unemployment Compensation Act of 2002.

May 28, 2003 [H.R. 2185]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

Unemployment Compensation Amendments of 26 USC 1 note.

## SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the "Unemployment Compensation Amendments of 2003".

## SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF THE TEMPORARY EXTENDED UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION ACT OF 2002.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 208 of the Temporary Extended Unemployment Compensation Act of 2002 (Public Law 107–147; 116 Stat. 30), as amended by Public Law 108-1 (117 Stat. 3), is amended-

- (1) in subsection (a)(2), by striking "before June 1" and
- inserting "on or before December 31";
  (2) in subsection (b)(1), by striking "May 31, 2003" and inserting "December 31, 2003";
  - (3) in subsection (b)(2)-
  - (A) in the heading, by striking "MAY 31, 2003" and inserting "DECEMBER 31, 2003"; and (B) by striking "May 31, 2003" and inserting "December
  - 31, 2003"; and
- (4) in subsection (b)(3), by striking "August 30, 2003" and inserting "March 31, 2004".
  (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by this section
- shall take effect as if included in the enactment of the Temporary Extended Unemployment Compensation Act of 2002 (Public Law 107-147; 116 Stat. 21).
