DECEMBER 1963

The Department of Commerce announced today that December 1963 retail store sales totaled \$25.6 billion, bringing sales for the full year 1963 to \$247.0 billion. After adjustment for seasonal variations and trading day differences, but not for price changes, total retail sales for December amounted to \$21.5 billion, about 4 percent above the previous month and 6 percent above December 1962.

The Office of Business Economics noted that after adjustment for seasonal variation and trading day differences virtually every line of trade shared in the sales advance from November to December. This large rise may be attributable to a shift of sales from November to December following the assassination of President John F. Kennedy and the late occurrence of Thanksgiving. Fourth quarter sales were about 2% above the third quarter with durables up 5% and nondurables unchanged. Based on the full sample, seasonally adjusted sales of all retail stores in November were virtually unchanged from October.

The December sales figures are based on a monthly survey of the Bureau of the Census conducted in cooperation with a representative cross-section of about 2,000 retail firms which, in total, operate some 40,000 stores in the United States. The firms which are cooperating in the early reporting of sales are part of a larger sample group which furnishes figures at a later date. The advance estimates are subject to revision by the estimates subsequently derived from the full sample.

The revision of the total seldom exceeds 1.5 percent, and for the past year has averaged 0.6 percent. For individual kind-of-business groups, revisions have been greater, ranging on the average from 1.0 percent for the food group to 2.2 percent for the furniture and appliance group.
