REPEAT SEX OFFENDER SENTENCED TO 29 YEARS IN PRISON

PHOENIX – Harry Savage, 36, of Kaibeto, Ariz., was sentenced here by U.S. District Judge James A. Teilborg to 27 years in federal prison followed by lifetime supervised release. Savage pleaded guilty on January 16, 2008 to Aggravated Sexual Abuse. He was also sentenced to two years in prison for violating his supervised release which had been imposed for Abusive Sexual Contact of a Minor in 2002. These sentences will run consecutively for a total sentence of 29 years in federal prison. This is his third conviction for sexual crimes.

In August 2007 Savage, who is HIV positive, broke into a home in Kaibeto and beat and sexually assaulted a 61-year-old woman, breaking four ribs and causing other trauma. She was able to call police, then ran from the home, where police found her bleeding and hiding behind a tree. Savage was found asleep in the victim's bed and was arrested.

The sentencing occurred on Tuesday, September 30, 2008. The investigation in this case was conducted by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Navajo Department of Criminal Investigation. The prosecution was handled by Dyanne C. Greer, Assistant U.S. Attorney, District of Arizona, Phoenix.
