ROUND ROCK MAN SENTENCED TO FEDERAL PRISON FOR ASSAULT

PHOENIX – Rayaundal Lyle Comb, 19, of Round Rock, Ariz., was sentenced here yesterday by U.S. District Judge G. Murray Snow to 30 months in federal prison for Assault Resulting in Serious Bodily Injury. Comb pleaded guilty on March 31, 2008.

The victim and the defendant had been drinking together when they began to argue over beer. The victim's sister, who is engaged to Comb, ordered Comb to leave. As Comb began to pull out of the driveway, the victim followed him. The victim kept yelling at Comb and began to run toward him. Comb then pulled out his .22 rifle and shot the victim, puncturing his liver.

The investigation in this case was conducted by Navajo Department of Criminal Investigations and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The prosecution was handled by Mark Brnovich, Assistant U.S. Attorney, District of Arizona, Phoenix.
