NEWS RELEASE SUMMARY - April 1, 2008

United States Attorney Karen P. Hewitt announced that Gustavo Antonio Beltran-Rodriguez was sentenced today in federal court in San Diego by United States District Judge Thomas J. Whelan to serve 70 months in custody based on his conviction for federal firearms and narcotics violations and reentry into the United States after deportation.

In connection with his guilty plea on September 10, 2007, Beltran-Rodriguez admitted to being a felon and illegal alien in possession of firearms, including a Colt .45 caliber semi-automatic handgun, a Bayard 7.65mm semi-automatic handgun, and a Mossberg .22 caliber handgun. In his plea, Beltran-Rodriguez also admitted to illegal possessing with intent to distribute approximately 79.68 grams of heroin and 29.92 grams of methamphetamine, and to being a previously deported alien illegally in the United States.
