#### **NEWS RELEASE SUMMARY - June 13, 2008**

San Diego, CA - United States Attorney Karen P. Hewitt announced that Anthony Andrew Sibley was sentenced today in federal court in San Diego by the Honorable Jeffrey T. Miller to serve a custodial sentence of 75 months, based on Sibley's conviction for possession of an unregistered silencer, possession of a firearm with a removed or obliterated serial number, possession of a firearm in connection with a drug trafficking offense, illegal possession of a firearm while under indictment, and two counts of possession of marijuana with the intent to distribute. Judge Miller also ordered that Sibley serve a three-year term of supervised release following the completion of his prison term.

In connection with his guilty plea on November 6, 2007, Sibley forfeited seven firearms, including a silencer and a pistol that had its serial number obliterated.

United States Attorney Hewitt praised the efforts of the Drug Enforcement Administration and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, which jointly investigated this case.
