NEWS RELEASE SUMMARY - June 20, 2008

United States Attorney Karen P. Hewitt announced that Yolanda Gutierrez-Castro was sentenced today in federal court in San Diego by the Honorable William Q. Hayes to serve 148 months in custody based upon her conviction for one count of conspiracy to distribute cocaine and one count of possession of cocaine with intent to distribute. Gutierrez-Castro was convicted after a jury trial on July 6, 2007.

According to evidence presented at trial, Gutierrez-Castro was arrested on March 6, 2007, at the Highway 86 Checkpoint near Westmorland, California, as the driver of a Honda Odyssey. A close inspection of the vehicle by U.S. Border Patrol agents resulted in the discovery and seizure of 24 packages of cocaine in a hidden compartment located in the roof of the van. The cocaine had a net weight of approximately 29.85 kilograms (65.80 pounds).
