The Health of Our Troops - Follow-up Training

Portland, Maine: In September, the Maine Chiefs of Police Association, the Maine Criminal Justice Academy, the Maine National Guard and the United States Attorney's Office hosted a training about the support systems available for a returning veteran upon reentering the law enforcement work force. The response from this training was very positive and as a result, the Maine Chief's Association requested this training be offered to law enforcement supervisors.

Based on this request, a follow-up training for law enforcement supervisors was held on Tuesday in Portland. A similar training program will be presented on December 7, 2007 at 8:30 a.m. at the Armed Forces Reserve Center in Bangor.
