Hampden Woman Sentenced for Mailing Bomb Threats

Bangor, Maine: United States Attorney Paula D. Silsby announced that **Jodi Lynn Holmes**, age 46, of Hampden, Maine, was sentenced on February 27, 2008 in U.S. District Court in Bangor, Maine, to 24 months imprisonment, 3 years supervised release, and a special assessment of \$100.00. In November 2007, Holmes pled guilty to Mailing Bomb Threats.

Court records reveal that on March 23, 2007, Holmes mailed three false bomb threat letters, one to each of John Bapst Memorial High School, Hampden Academy and Bangor Christian Schools. The letters indicated that bombs would go off at each school on the same date and time.

United States Attorney Silsby praised the investigation conducted by the U.S. Postal Inspection Service, the Bangor Police Department, the Hampden Police Department, the Penobscot County Sheriff's office and the Maine State Police.
