## William F. Bater Sentenced For Federal Firearms Charge

Portland, Maine: United States Attorney Paula D. Silsby announced that William F. Bater, age 44, formerly of Bridgton, Maine and Bridgewater, Massachusetts, was sentenced in U.S. District Court to 17 years in prison to be followed by 5 years of supervised release. Mr. Bater was found guilty by a federal jury on May 29, 2008, of being a felon in possession of a firearm. He was indicted by a federal grand jury on September 18, 2007.

The Indictment alleged that Mr. Bater possessed a Remington Model 742, .308 caliber rifle after having been convicted of five felony offenses including, breaking and entering in the daytime in Massachusetts in 1982 and 1989, burglary of a dwelling in Florida in 1983, burglary in Utah in 1984, and concealment of a stolen firearm in Massachusetts in 1993. According to Court records, the defendant acquired the rifle by having another individual purchase it for him in what is commonly referred to as a "straw purchase." Because of his multiple prior felony convictions, Mr. Bater was subject to enhanced sentencing as an Armed Career Criminal.
