DRESSLERVILLE PIT CLOSURE ORDER

A. PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area and roads as described in this order, in the Carson City Ranger District, Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest until further notice.

 It is prohibited to go into or be upon any area which is closed for the protection of property.
[36 CFR 261.53(f)]

B. EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), each of the following are exempt from this order.

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
- 2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

C. AREA DESCRIBED

Area, commonly known as the Dresslerville Pit, located South of National Forest System Road 41676 and West of National Forest System Road 41677, on the Carson City Ranger District, Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest. As shown on Exhibit A, Map, and incorporated as part of this ORDER. The Dresslerville Pit is currently fenced, as show on Exhibit A, Map.

D. <u>PURPOSE</u>

The purpose of this order is to protect the Dresslerville Pit area rehabilitation work that was recently completed and is part of the Carson Ranger Districts overall management strategy for the Dresslerville area.

E. <u>IMPLEMENTATION</u>

- 1. This Special Order implementing Area Closure Restrictions is effective at 11:59 P.M. On March 21, 2008, and shall remain in effect until rescinded.
- 2. Exhibit A, Map, Exhibit B, Definitions are attached and incorporated into this ORDER.



EXHIBIT B

DEFINITIONS

Dresslerville Pit Closure

<u>AREA:</u> Means a discrete, specifically delineated space that is smaller, and in most cases much smaller, than a Ranger District.

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS: means a forest road other than a road which has been authorized by a legally documented right-a-way held by a State, county, or other local public road authority.
