Disabling 2006 Direct and Counter-Cyclical (CC) Payment Processing

1 Overview

A Background

The Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 provided for direct and CC payments for covered commodities, oilseeds, and peanuts beginning with crop years 2002 through 2007. The 2006 direct and CC payment and overpayment processes use supporting files to determine whether a producer has been underpaid or overpaid. Because some of the supporting files only maintain data for the most current 3 years, some of the:

- outstanding payments **cannot** be processed because the supporting files **cannot** be updated
- producers may be listed on the overpayment register that are **not** actually overpaid.

B Purpose

This notice informs State and County Offices that:

• direct and CC payment and overpayment processing for crop year 2006 will be disabled after installing County Release No. 650

Note: The producer payment history (PPH) and CCC-509E will be the only processing options available after installing County Release No. 650.

• they will be required to submit documentation to the National Office where a 2006 direct or CC payment was earned by the producer, but **not** issued **before** County Release No. 650 disabled the payment processing software.

A State Office Action

State Offices shall:

- ensure that County Offices:
 - are immediately informed of the contents of this notice
 - have issued all outstanding 2006 direct and CC payments
 - computed and transferred all 2006 direct and CC overpayments to the Common Receivable System (CRS)
- forward authorization request documentation to PECD, CPB, using either of the following methods:

 - overnight mail to:

Note: Requests **must** be accompanied by a statement from DD explaining why the County Office was unable to process payments for 2006 before October 2008.

B County Office Action

County Offices shall:

- issue any outstanding 2006direct and CC payments to eligible producers before installing County Release No. 650 unless prohibited by reasons **not** within their control
- compute and transfer 2006 direct and CC overpayments for all farms to ensure that all debts are transferred to CRS

Note: After overpayment software is disabled in County Release No. 650, County Offices shall enter an overpayment according to 67-FI, if it is determined that an overpayment has occurred.

B County Office Action (Continued)

- ensure that County Release No. 650 is installed upon receipt
- submit the following crop year 2006 documentation to the State Office for any direct or CC payment that was **not** issued before installing County Release No. 650:
 - explanation about why a 2006 payment was **not** issued before installing County Release No. 650
 - CCC-509
 - CCC-509E
 - direct or CC PPH

Reminders: If the producer is a joint operation, PPH **must** be submitted for each member of the joint operation.

PPH **must** be submitted for each combined producer, if applicable.

Note: PPH shall be printed by selecting the applicable menu options from the enabled 2006 direct or CC payment menus. An accounting history print or transaction statement will **not** be accepted in place of PPH from the direct or CC processing menus.

- current MABDIG for each:
 - producer
 - affected member of the joint operation
- 2006 Farm Payment Reduction Report, printed from the Compliance options.
