

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4547
OFFERED BY MR. STUMP

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert
following:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Cost of War Against
3 Terrorism Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2003”

4 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL AUTHORIZATIONS**

5 Amounts authorized to be appropriated by this Act
6 are in addition to other amounts authorized to be appro-
7 priated for military functions of the Department of De-
8 fense for fiscal year 2003.

9 **TITLE I—PROCUREMENT**

10 **SEC. 101. ARMY.**

11 Funds are hereby authorized to be appropriated for
12 fiscal year 2003 for Other Procurement, Army, in the
13 amount of \$10,700,000.

14 **SEC. 102. NAVY AND MARINE CORPS.**

15 (a) NAVY.—Funds are hereby authorized to be appro-
16 priated for fiscal year 2003 for procurement for the Navy
17 as follows:

18 (1) For aircraft, \$106,000,000.

19 (2) For weapons, including missiles and
20 pedoes, \$598,000,000.

(b) MARINE CORPS.—Funds are hereby authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year 2003 for procurement for the Marine Corps in the amount of \$25,200,000.

(c) NAVY AND MARINE CORPS AMMUNITION.—Funds are hereby authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year 2003 for procurement of ammunition for the Navy and the Marine Corps in the amount of \$95,600,000.

SEC. 103. AIR FORCE.

Funds are hereby authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year 2003 for procurement for the Air Force as follows:

- (1) For aircraft, \$214,550,000.
- (2) For ammunition, \$117,900,000.
- (4) For other procurement, \$10,800,000.

SEC. 104. DEFENSE-WIDE ACTIVITIES.

Funds are hereby authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year 2003 for Defense-wide procurement in the amount of \$616,414,000.

SEC. 105. GLOBAL INFORMATION GRID SYSTEM.

None of the funds authorized to be appropriated by this Act for the Department of Defense system known as the Global Information Grid may be obligated until the Secretary of Defense certifies to the congressional defense committees that the end-to-end system is secure and pro-

1 tected from unauthorized access to the information trans-
2 mitted through the system.

3 **TITLE II—RESEARCH, DEVELOP-**
4 **MENT, TEST, AND EVALUA-**
5 **TION**

6 **SEC. 201. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

7 Funds are hereby authorized to be appropriated for
8 fiscal year 2003 for the use of the Department of Defense
9 for research, development, test, and evaluation for De-
10 fense-wide activities in the amount of \$390,100,000.

11 **TITLE III—OPERATION AND**
12 **MAINTENANCE**

13 **SEC. 301. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE FUNDING.**

14 Funds are hereby authorized to be appropriated for
15 fiscal year 2003 for the use of the Armed Forces for ex-
16 penses, not otherwise provided for, for operation and
17 maintenance, in amounts as follows:

- 18 (1) For the Army, \$14,400,000.
19 (2) For the Navy, \$5,300,000.
20 (3) For the Marine Corps, \$11,500,000.
21 (4) For the Air Force, \$900,000,000.

**TITLE IV—MILITARY
PERSONNEL**

3 **SEC. 401. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR MILI-**
4 **TARY PERSONNEL.**

5 There is hereby authorized to be appropriated to the
6 Department of Defense for military personnel for fiscal
7 year 2003 a total of \$503,100,000.

8 **TITLE V—WARTIME PAY AND**
9 **ALLOWANCE INCREASES**

10 **SEC. 501. INCREASE IN RATE FOR FAMILY SEPARATION AL-**
11 **LOWANCE.**

12 Section 427(a)(1) of title 37, United States Code, is
13 amended by striking “\$100” and inserting “\$125”

14 **SEC. 502. INCREASE IN RATES FOR VARIOUS HAZARDOUS**
15 **DUTY INCENTIVE PAYS.**

16 (a) **FLIGHT PAY FOR CREW MEMBERS.**—Subsection
17 (b) of section 301 of title 37, United States Code, is
18 amended by striking the table and inserting the following
19 new table:

4 (c) OTHER HAZARDOUS DUTIES.—Subsection (c)(1)
 5 of such section is amended by striking “\$150” and insert-
 6 ing “\$200”.

7 (d) REMOVAL OF AIR WEAPONS CONTROLLER CREW
 8 MEMBERS FROM LIST OF HAZARDOUS DUTIES.—Such
 9 section is further amended—

- 10 (1) in subsection (a)—
- 11 (A) by striking paragraph (12);
- 12 (B) in paragraph (11), by striking “; or”
- 13 and inserting a period; and
- 14 (C) in paragraph (10), by inserting “or”
- 15 after the semicolon; and
- 16 (2) in subsection (c), as amended by sub-
 17 sections (b) and (c) of this section—
- 18 (A) by striking “(1)”;
- 19 (B) by striking paragraph (2).

1 **SEC. 503. INCREASE IN RATE FOR DIVING DUTY SPECIAL**
2 **PAY.**

3 Section 304(b) of title 37, United States Code, is
4 amended—

5 (1) by striking “\$240” and inserting “\$290”;
6 and

7 (2) by striking “\$340” and inserting “\$390”.

8 **SEC. 504. INCREASE IN RATE FOR IMMINENT DANGER PAY.**

9 Section 310(a) of title 37, United States Code, is
10 amended by striking “\$150” and inserting “\$250”.

11 **SEC. 505. INCREASE IN RATE FOR CAREER ENLISTED**
12 **FLYER INCENTIVE PAY.**

13 The table in section 320(d) of title 37, United States
14 Code, is amended to read as follows:

“Years of aviation service	Monthly rate
4 or less	\$200
Over 4	\$275
Over 8	\$400
Over 14	\$450.”.

15 **SEC. 506. INCREASE IN AMOUNT OF DEATH GRATUITY.**

16 Section 1478(a) of title 10, United States Code, is
17 amended by striking “\$6,000” and inserting “\$12,000”.

18 **SEC. 507. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

19 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The amendments made by this
20 title shall take effect on the later of the following:

21 (1) The first day of the first month beginning
22 on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.

23 (2) October 1, 2002

1 (b) DEATH GRATUITY.—The amendment made by
 2 section 506 shall apply with respect to a person covered
 3 by section 1475 or 1476 of title 10, United States Code,
 4 whose date of death occurs on or after the later of the
 5 following:

6 (1) The first day of the first month beginning
 7 on or after the date of the enactment of this

8 (2) October 1, 2002.

9 **TITLE VI—MILITARY CONSTRUCTION AUTHORIZATIONS**

11 **SEC. 601. AUTHORIZED MILITARY CONSTRUCTION AND**
 12 **LAND ACQUISITION PROJECTS.**

13 (a) PROJECTS AUTHORIZED. Using amounts appro-
 14 priated pursuant to the authorization of appropriations in
 15 subsection (b), the Secretary of the military department
 16 concerned may acquire real property and carry out
 17 tary construction projects for the installations and loca-
 18 tions, and in the amounts, set forth in the following table:

19 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Funds
 20 are hereby authorized to be appropriated for fiscal year

- 2 subsection (a) in the total amount of \$35,080,000.
