- 1) <u>H.Res.</u> Offering heartfelt condolences to the victims and their families regarding the horrific violence at Virginia Tech in Blacksburg, Virginia, and to students, faculty, administration and staff and their families who have been deeply affected by the tragic events that occurred there (Rep. Boucher Education and Labor)
- 2) <u>H.Res.300</u> Commending the achievements of the Rutgers University women's basketball team and applauding the character and integrity of their student-athletes (*Rep. Pallone Education and Labor*)
- **H.Res.** Honoring the 53,000 soldiers, sailors, airmen, Marines, and civilians that comprise the Nation's special operations forces community (*Reps. Drake, Smith (WA) Armed Services*)
