On behalf of the 4.6 million members and supporters of the National Committee to Preserve Social Security and Medicare, I would like to express our strong support for H.R. 4, the Medicare Prescription Drug Negotiation Act of 2007, which is scheduled for a Floor vote later this week.

The National Committee is committed to finding ways to improve Medicare Part D. We commend Representatives Dingell, Emerson, Rangel and their cosponsors for introducing the Medicare Prescription Drug Negotiation Act. This bill would require the Secretary of Health and Human Services (HHS) to negotiate with drug companies for lower prices for Medicare beneficiaries, thereby benefiting Medicare beneficiaries and the American taxpayer.
