I am writing to request your testimony at a hearing on February 7, 2008, before the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform. The hearing will address executive compensation and severance arrangements for CEOs involved in the ongoing mortgage crisis.

According to press reports, you collected tens of millions of dollars in payments and other compensation upon your departure from Citigroup. I request that you be prepared to provide your perspective on this reported pay package. You should plan to address how it aligns with the interests of Citigroup's shareholders and whether this level of compensation is justified in light of your company's recent performance and its role in the national mortgage crisis.
