- 2. All documents regarding the retention or dismissal of outside advisors retained to assist the compensation committee, the board of directors, or management with its determination of any compensation (including severance terms) of Mr. Prince in his capacity as Chief Executive Officer.
- 3. Documents sufficient to identify all outside advisors involved in determining any compensation (including severance terms) of Mr. Prince in his capacity as Chief Executive Officer, including advisors retained on behalf of Mr. Prince, compensation consultants, executive placement firms, and attorneys. For each outside advisor, please identify the individual or entity who retained them, the individual or entity they represented (if different), and the dates of their retainer.
