- 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Comptroller General of the
- 4 General Accountability Office shall conduct a study of li-
- 5 ability and indemnity agreements governing commuter
- 6 and intercity passenger rail services.
- 7 (b) CONTENTS OF STUDY.—The study shall examine
- 8 the agreements currently governing commuter and inter-
- 9 city passenger rail services, and new agreements under
- 10 consideration, between operators of commuter rail public
- 11 transportation and freight railroads, operators of com-
- 12 muter rail public transportation and Amtrak, and Amtrak
- 13 and freight railroads. The study shall examine the liability
- 14 provisions of these agreements, including the indemnity
- 15 agreements in place, the historic development of these
- 16 agreements, how the Federal and State courts have inter-
- 17 preted these agreements, the financial obligations of these
- 18 agreements, and any concerns with these agreements as
