

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3021, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. TOM DAVIS OF VIRGINIA**

Page 5, after line 24, insert the following (and re-designate provisions accordingly):

1 (b) RESERVATION FOR SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY
2 SCHOOLS.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—From the amount appro-
4 priated to carry out this title for each fiscal year,
5 the Secretary shall reserve 1 percent of such
6 amount, consistent with section 101, to provide as-
7 sistance to secondary schools described in paragraph
8 (2).

9 (2) SCHOOLS DESCRIBED.—A school is de-
10 scribed in this paragraph if the school is a secondary
11 school recognized as a Science and Technology High
12 School or as a secondary school with a science and
13 technology program. The requirements for such rec-
14 ognition shall be determined by the Secretary of
15 Education, taking into consideration the following
16 specific criteria:

17 (A) The secondary school must meet a
18 minimum number of required academic years of
19 science curriculum.

1 (B) The secondary school must meet a
2 minimum number of academic years of tech-
3 nology or engineering curriculum.

4 (C) The secondary school must meet a
5 minimum number of academic years of mathe-
6 matics curriculum.
