COMMITTEE ACTION

The Committee on Homeland Security Subcommittee on Intelligence, Information Sharing, and Terrorism Risk Assessment met, pursuant to notice, in open markup session, a quorum being present, on Tuesday, July 17, 2007, in 311 Cannon House Office Building to consider H.R. 1955, to prevent homegrown terrorism, and for other purposes.
