

2. AN AMENDMENT TO BE OFFERED BY REPRESENTATIVE  
Pearce OF New Mexico, OR HIS  
DESIGNEE, DEBATABLE FOR 10 MINUTES:

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1286, AS REPORTED

OFFERED BY MR. PEARCE NMOR

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 SEC. 4. ENERGY AND CONGRESSIONAL REVIEW.

2 The Secretary of Interior, in consultation with the  
3 Secretary of Energy and private industry, shall complete  
4 and submit to the Committee on Natural Resources of the  
5 House of Representatives, the Committee on Energy and  
6 Natural Resources of the Senate, and Senators and Rep-  
7 resentatives from the States affected by the designation,  
8 a report using the best available data and regarding the  
9 energy resources available on the lands and waters in-  
10 cluded in the Washington-Rochambeau Revolutionary  
11 Route National Historic Trail. The report shall—

12 (1) contain the best available description of the  
13 energy resources available on the land and report on  
14 the specific amount of energy withdrawn from pos-  
15 sible development; and

16 (2) identify barrels of oil, cubic feet of natural  
17 gas, megawatts of geothermal, wind and solar energy  
18 that could be commercially produced, annual avail-  
19 able biomass for energy production, and any  
20 megawatts of hydropower resources available, includ-

- 1 ing tidal, traditional dams, and in- stream flow tur-
- 2 bines, and any impact on electricity transmission.
