

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 415, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. PEARCE OF NEW MEXICO

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 SEC. 3. ENERGY AND CONGRESSIONAL REVIEW.

2 The Secretary of the Interior, in consultation with the
3 Secretary of Energy and private industry, shall complete
4 and submit to the Committee on Natural Resources of the
5 House of Representatives, the Committee on Energy and
6 Natural Resources of the Senate, and Senators and Rep-
7 resentatives from the States affected by the designation,
8 a report using the best available data and regarding the
9 energy resources available on the lands and waters in-
10 cluded in the segments of the Taunton River designated
11 under section 2 of this Act. The report shall—

12 (1) contain the best available description of the
13 energy resources available on the land and report on
14 the specific amount of energy withdrawn from pos-
15 sible development; and

16 (2) identify cubic feet of natural gas, natural
17 gas transmission and storage potential, megawatts
18 of geothermal, wind and solar energy that could be
19 commercially produced, annual available biomass for
20 energy production, and any megawatts of hydro-

- 1 power resources available, including tidal, traditional
- 2 dams, and in-stream flow turbines.
