

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5959, AS REPORTED

OFFERED BY MR. CASTLE OF DELAWARE and *Mr. Shays of Connecticut*

At the end of subtitle A of title V, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 506. SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING ESTABLISH-**
2 **MENT OF COMMITTEES WITH JURISDICTION**
3 **OVER INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES.**

4 It is the sense of Congress that beginning with the
5 One Hundred Eleventh Congress, the House of Represent-
6 atives and the Senate should, in accordance with the rec-
7 ommendations of the National Commission on Terrorist
8 Attacks Upon the United States (commonly known as the
9 "9/11 Commission")—

10 (1) each establish in the Committee on Appro-
11 priations of the House of Representatives or Senate
12 (as the case may be) a Subcommittee on Intel-
13 ligence, which should have jurisdiction over all ac-
14 tivities of such Committee which relate to intel-
15 ligence and intelligence-related activities of the
16 United States Government;

17 (2) establish a Joint Committee on Intelligence,
18 which should have jurisdiction over authorization of
19 and appropriations for intelligence and intelligence-

1 related activities of the United States Government;

2 or

3 (3) each establish a Committee on Intelligence,

4 which should have jurisdiction over authorization of

5 and appropriations for intelligence and intelligence-

6 related activities of the United States Government.
