**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5959, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. HINCHEY OF NEW YORK**

At the end of subtitle B of tile IV, add the following
new section:

1 **SEC. 426. REPORT ON ACTIVITIES OF THE CENTRAL INTEL-**
2 **LIGENCE AGENCY IN ARGENTINA.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 270 days after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of the Cen-
5 tral Intelligence Agency shall submit to the appropriate
6 congressional committees a report containing the fol-
7 lowing:

8 (1) A description of any information in the pos-
9 session of the intelligence community with respect to
10 the following events in the Republic of Argentina:

11 (A) The accession to power by the Military
12 of the Republic of Argentina in 1976.

13 (B) Violations of human rights committed
14 by officers or agents of the Argentine military
15 and security forces.

16 (C) Operation Condor and the fate of Ar-
17 gentine people targeted, abducted, or killed dur-
18 ing such Operation, including Argentine chil-

1 dren born in captivity whose status remains un-
2 known.

3 (2) All information that may lead to the dis-
4 covery of the Argentine children born in captivity
5 whose status remains unknown.

6 (3) A compilation of information referred to in
7 paragraphs (1) and (2) that has been declassified.

8 (b) UPDATE OF COMPILATION.—Not later than one
9 year after the date on which the report required under
10 subsection (a) is submitted, and annually thereafter for
11 three years, the Director of the Central Intelligence Agen-
12 cy shall submit to the appropriate congressional commit-
13 tees an update of the compilation referred to in subsection
14 (a)(3).

15 (c) FORM.—The report required under subsection (a)
16 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
17 a classified annex.

18 (d) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “appro-
19 priate congressional committees” means the Permanent
20 Select Committee on Intelligence and the Committee on
21 Appropriations of the House of Representatives and the
22 Select Committee on Intelligence and the Committee on
23 Appropriations of the Senate.
