Bald Eagle

Largest of the forest birds, nesting quietly alone in snags, marsh.

Great Horned Owl: Has roosts in virtually all of the forest regions of Central and South America. It eats porcupines, beavers, leopards, and frogs. It is seen only by the rare Great Gray Owl.

American Kestrel: Formerly called the Hawk, this bird has adapted to both the open fields and the wooded areas. It feeds on small birds and rodents. In the city it feeds on House Sparrows.

Wood Rat: With a long, scaly tail, the Wood Rat can produce the loudest noise made by any creature of the forest. When calling, it sounds like a whistle.

Night Hawk: Insects are the main food of the Night Hawk. It is a common sight in the forest at night.



White-tailed Deer: Lacking opposable thumbs, the deer strip away vegetation. When startled, the animal will raise its tail and show the white underside. This can be seen by other deer and by hunters in flight.



Raccoon: Raccoons are found from the Atlantic to the Pacific. They are very adaptable and are found in a wide variety of habitats. They are known for their intelligence and ability to learn from experience.



Skunk: Skunks belong to the weasel family. They are known for their ability to spray a strong, foul-smelling liquid. They are found in a wide variety of habitats.



Porcupine: The porcupine is a large mammal. It is known for its long, sharp quills. It is found in a wide variety of habitats.

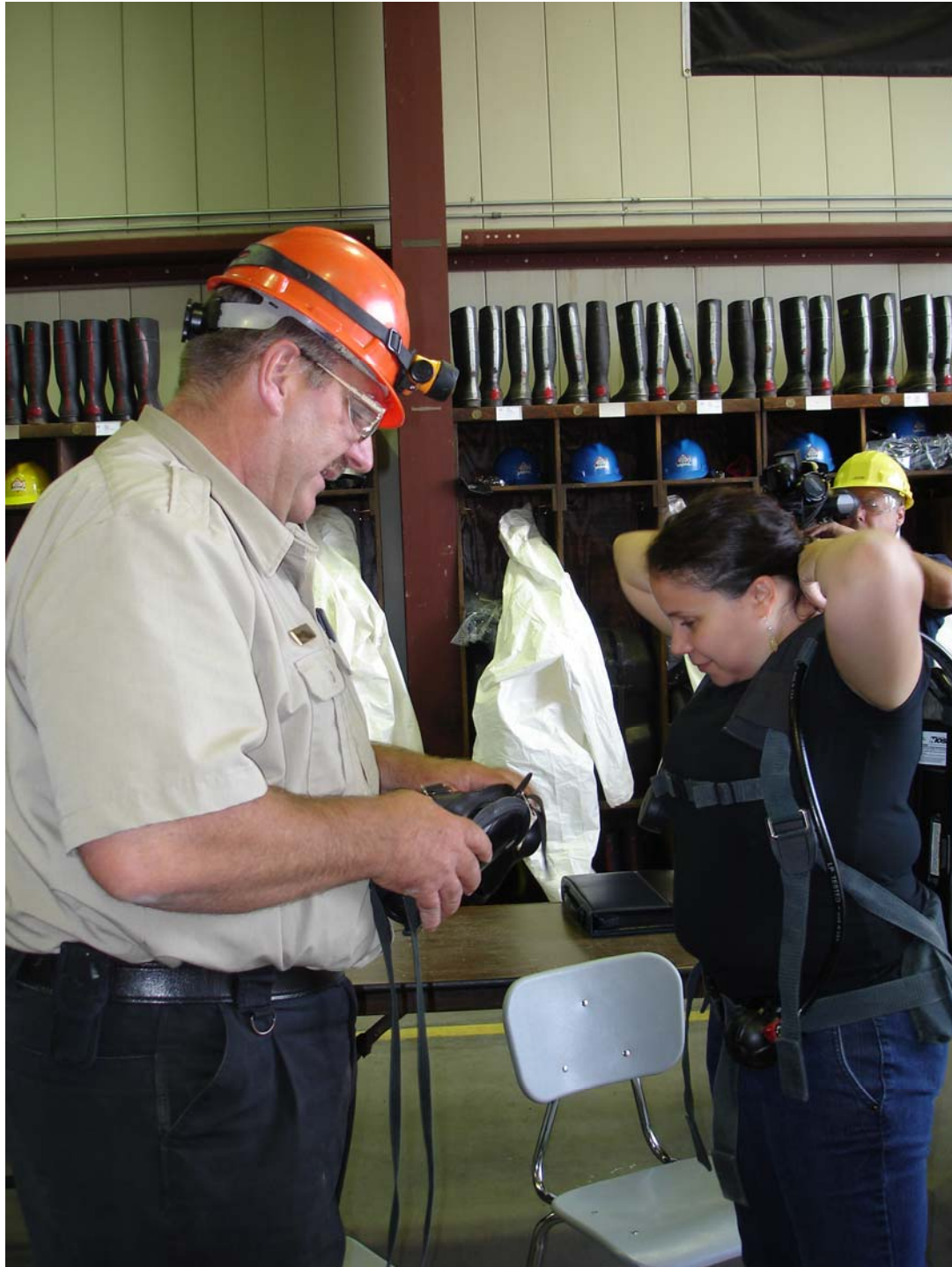
