BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE: The Cooperative State Research, Education, and Extension Service (CSREES) continues to fully support the intent of the President's Management Agenda initiative on Expanded E-Government and P.L. 106-107 through the expanded use of Grants.gov for the submission of CSREES grant applications in fiscal year (FY) 2008. The purpose of this Grants Policy and Procedure Bulletin (GPP Bulletin) is to promulgate and clarify the CSREES policy for attachments to grant applications submitted via [Grants.gov](#).

CSREES GPP Bulletins serve to clarify, supplement, and/or interpret Federal assistance legislation and regulations for CSREES applicants and recipients.

POLICY AND PROCEDURES: One of the requirements for submitting CSREES grant applications via Grants.Gov is that **ALL** attachments must be in Portable Document Format (PDF).

Note the attachment requirements (e.g., portable document format) in Part III section 3. of the CSREES Grants.gov Application Guide available with the Application Package at Grants.gov. Any proposals containing non-PDF documents will be at the risk of being excluded from CSREES review. Partial applications will be excluded from consideration. With documented prior approval, resubmitted applications will be accepted until close of business (COB) on the closing date of the RFA.

If you do not own PDF generating software, Grants.gov provides online tools to assist applicants. Users will find a link to “PDF Conversion Programs” on (http://www.grants.gov/resources/download_software.jsp#pdf_conversion_programs).
