We are circulating Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Draft Engineering Brief (EB) No. 7X, REJUVENATION PRODUCT QUALIFICATION PROCEDURE REQUIREMENTS, to interested industry associations to obtain comments and recommendations of actions to be taken. Please review this draft and submit comments as appropriate. The final document may be revised as a result of comments received and our further review.

EB No. 7X outlines the procedures for evaluating and assessing candidate rejuvenation products that lack the documented 2-year minimum successful field performance required by proposed Paragraph 6XX-2.2, "Performance Documentation" in proposed Item P-6XX, Bituminous Pavement Rejuvenation.
