Community Collecting Area
General Requirements

- Use of this site is for small, non –commercial users only, unless other arrangements have been made. The rock is not intended for resale.
- Make certain that you are not on State or Private land. Look for FS boundary signs. Check a map.
- Rocks will be loaded by hand.
- Do not block the road.
- Do not haul on the road when the conditions are wet.
- Slow speeds, generally less than 15 miles per hour will be maintained by vehicle operators.
- No large holes or unnatural appearing excavations will be made in the talus slopes.
- If any archeologically significant items are discovered, the operation will stop, and the Forest Service will be notified.
- Rock will not be removed from outside the talus area. Surface disturbance will be minimal.

Rule of thumb conversions are:

For solid rock: 1 cu yd = 2 tons,

For loose gravel and sand: 1 cu yd = 1.5 tons

One standard 10 yd truck holds 9 lcy (loose cubic yards) of sand and gravel

One full size pickup can hold 1 – 1.5 tons, or 1 lcy sand and gravel (max)

Small pickup can hold .5 ton
