



**Action Items from Thursday, October 18, 2007
ENERGY STAR® TV Stakeholder Meeting**

1. EPA to distribute stakeholder meeting materials.
2. EPA to schedule a follow-up conference call to discuss key topics:
 - a. Download Acquisition Mode (DAM) functionality and testing;
 - b. Features such as Wide Color Gamut for TVs;
 - c. TV monitors;
 - d. TVs with Public Alert;
 - e. Panasonic proposal made at stakeholder meeting to modify slope of the specification line for 1080 TVs; and,
 - f. Forced-menu option *if* consumers must select a picture mode upon initially turning their TV on in order to display a picture.
3. EPA to review and summarize for discussion the stakeholder material previously submitted on Public Alert (2003 timeframe) and offer proposed approach and key remaining questions related to TVs with this feature.
4. EPA to summarize assumptions behind savings numbers presented at meeting and distribute to stakeholders.
5. EPA to consider all comments related to IEC 62087 references in Draft 2 and edit the draft specification appropriately prior to the release of the next draft.
6. CEA to determine whether market share projections by TV technology-type can be shared with EPA for 2009 or 2010.
7. CEA to work with their members to develop a proposal for DAM, e.g., what functionality should be addressed by DAM, how should manufacturers test their TVs in this mode, and what should proposed requirements be for wattage/time in DAM.
