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WATER SAMPLING RESULTS SHOW DECREASED BACTERIA LEVELS AT SOME WINDWARD BEACHES

HONOLULU – The Hawaii State Department of Health (DOH) has determined that tests on water samples collected on Saturday, March 11, 2006 show that bacteria levels have fallen to safe levels at Waimanalo, Kailua Bay, and Heeia-Nahiku. Those areas will have warning signs removed.

Warnings will remain in place at Kaneohe Beach Park, the area around Kaneohe Stream where it enters into Kaneohe Bay and Kualoa Park. In these areas, warning signs will stay up and water sampling will continue.
