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DOH CITES CONOCOPHILLIPS COMPANY (Hawaii) FOR A PERFORMANCE TEST VIOLATION

The Hawaii State Department of Health, Clean Air Branch (Department), has issued a Notice of Violation (Docket No. 06-CA-EO-03) against ConocoPhillips Company (Hawaii), for a permit violation. ConocoPhillips Company has been cited for violating its Covered Source Permit (CSP) No. 0202-01-C by exceeding the total organic compound emission limit specified in the CSP while conducting the required annual performance test in 2005 for the John Zink Vapor Combustion Unit.

ConocoPhillips Company had operated a petroleum bulk loading terminal at 411 Pacific Street, Honolulu, Hawaii. Conducting the required tests are important to ensure continuing compliance of the facility with applicable state and federal emissions requirements and to minimize impact to the public. A penalty of \$4,500 has been imposed on ConocoPhillips Company.

ConocoPhillips Company has twenty days to contest the order, and if it does so, the case will be scheduled for a hearing.

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
