DOH CITES ROLLOFFS HAWAII FOR DEPOSIT BEVERAGE CONTAINER VIOLATION

HONOLULU — The Hawaii State Department of Health, Solid & Hazardous Waste Branch, has filed a Notice and Finding of Violation against Rolloffs Hawaii Inc., dba RRR Recycling Services Hawaii (RRR Recycling). The company is being cited for using about 6 to 9 tons of deposit beverage container glass, collected from their certified redemption center network, as fill material on unapproved land.

The land used was not identified in RRR Recycling's redemption center certification application as an end-use destination for deposit beverage containers and not an approved recycling destination. The land was also deemed a wetland by the United States Army Corps of Engineers, and Rolloffs lacked the required Corps permit to grade or fill the property. The Corps has taken separate action.

RRR Recycling operates a certified redemption center network, which provides recycling and redemption services under Hawaii's deposit beverage container program.

DOH assessed a penalty of \$1,199 against RRR Recycling for its violation. RRR Recycling has complied with the Notice and Finding of Violation and Order and paid the penalty.
