DOH ANNOUNCES COMMUNITY BOOSTER SEAT CHECK-UP EVENTS

HONOLULU – The Hawaii State Department of Health is announcing free booster seat check-up events from January through March on Oahu, Maui, Hawaii and Kauai. The GEICO sponsored events are part of a statewide Booster Seat Information Campaign to educate the public about the new law and proper use of booster seats. The GEICO Gecko will be attending many of the check-up events. The public is reminded to bring their child or children, booster seat(s) and their car to have their seats checked and to learn how to install them properly.

With the passage of Hawaii's new booster seat law, as of January 1, 2007, all children ages four through seven are now required to ride in a child safety seat or a booster seat whenever traveling in a motor vehicle. The only exemptions are if the child is over 4'9" or if the vehicle has lap-only seat belts in the rear seat, in which case the child is not required to use a booster seat, but must wear the seat belt.

"The proper use of child passenger restraints is the most important factor in preventing death and disability in a car crash," said Health Director Dr. Chiyome Fukino. "Children in booster seats are 60 percent safer than in seat belts alone."

Seat belts were designed for older children and adults, not for young children, whose size and physical development make seat belts less effective, and in some cases, unsafe.

A Hawaii State tax credit of \$25 per year applies to the purchase of a child safety seat or booster seat.
