





Administrative Review

After Grants.gov validation, applications will be allowed for administrative review for approval. *E-mail notification*

Reasons for "Not Approved":

Submitted past deadline

Nonconformance to PDF requirements

Obvious formatting violations

Exceed budget limits





Peer Review

Once applications are approved for agency admittance, applications will be reviewed for acceptance for Peer Review. *F-mail notification*

Reasons for "Not Accepted":

Does not address program priorities or program relevance

Additional formatting or budgetary violations

Attachments not in PDF - 2.2%

No Conflict of Interest List – 2.8%

Not prepared to submit - Late Proposal
