Leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for starting the Trigo Fire on the Cibola National Forest on or about April 15, 2008.

Investigators have recently focused their attention on attempting to identify two individuals seen in the area just prior to the fire being reported to officials. These individuals may have been turkey hunting in Trigo Canyon as they were described as wearing camouflage clothing and carrying long guns. These two individuals were seen driving out of Trigo Canyon at a high rate of speed in a dark brown late 1990s model Ford truck when the fire began.

The Trigo Fire burned 59 homes and consumed 13,709 acres.
