e-LDP

With a Level 2 Account you can request a Loan Deficiency Payment (LDP) anytime from home and receive payment by direct deposit within 48 hours. Ask your FSA Office to establish an e-LDP profile.

e-DCP

With a Level 2 Account you can enroll in Direct and Counter-Cyclical Program (DCP) anytime. Choose program options, assign crop shares, and submit the contract from home.

- 4. You must bring your photo ID (driver's license) to a local USDA Service Center to have your "identity proofed." USDA will update your profile and within 1 hour you will have access to your account.

With a Level 2 Account you can grant business partners access to conduct your USDA business online and access to your USDA on-line records. Partners can include partnership members, corporation trustee, etc. Power-of-Attorneys are a future enhancement.
