MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF CONNECTICUT HAS  
REACHED AN ESTIMATED 898-THOUSAND. HISPANICS REPRESENT THE  
LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH 403-THOUSAND PEOPLE.  
SECOND WAS BLACKS, WITH 389-THOUSAND PEOPLE. NATIONALLY,  
HISPANICS REMAIN THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP, WITH BLACKS
