TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF IOWA HAS REACHED AN ESTIMATED
280-THOUSAND. HISPANICS REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY
GROUP HERE, WITH MORE THAN 120-THOUSAND PEOPLE. SECOND WAS
BLACKS, WITH 93-THOUSAND PEOPLE. NATIONALLY, HISPANICS
REMAIN THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP, WITH BLACKS SECOND. FOR
