MORE THAN ONE IN EVERY TEN MINNESOTA RESIDENTS IS A
MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF MINNESOTA HAS
REACHED AN ESTIMATED 742-THOUSAND. BLACKS REPRESENT THE
LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH 272-THOUSAND PEOPLE.
SECOND WAS HISPANICS, WITH 206-THOUSAND PEOPLE. NATIONALLY,
HISPANICS REMAIN THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP, WITH BLACKS
