MORE THAN FOUR IN EVERY TEN MISSISSIPPI RESIDENTS IS A
MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF MISSISSIPPI HAS
REACHED AN ESTIMATED ONE-POINT-TWO MILLION. BLACKS
REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH
ONE-POINT-ONE MILLION PEOPLE. SECOND WAS HISPANICS, WITH
60-THOUSAND PEOPLE. NATIONALLY, HISPANICS REMAIN THE
LARGEST MINORITY GROUP, WITH BLACKS SECOND. FOR MORE
